 - o During the last VSP Technical Panel meeting it was announced that all VSP counties are required to develop a monitoring plan as part of the fiscal year 23-25 deliverables. The monitoring plan is due before July 1, 2024.
 - o The conservation commission hosted a Monitoring Guide Forum in late March. The Monitoring guide is the document that VSP counties will use to develop monitoring plans for VSP. The guide is still in draft form and a final version of the guide should be available by July of this year.
